

ATA CLASSIFICATION

Classification will be as follows and all trophies will be shot for on this basis: **KNOWN ABILITY** as determined by Shoot Management.

All special categories must be declared with cashier at classification.

Each shooter must be classified by the Classification Committee composed of ASTA Officials. Pre-squadding and Classification begin on Wednesday 4:00 PM.

All 16 yard and doubles targets must be averaged before classification. Any targets shot and acquired on both and or Thursday May 29th, Friday, May 30th can be counted towards 2025 State Shoot requirements. The shooter must present card to be reclassified.

The Club will open each day at 7:30 AM for practice. Practice may be shot if fields are available. There will not be practice during the events. The program is scheduled to start at the stated times and will be shot on 7 fields. 100 targets per field. This is necessary in order to complete the events and shoot-offs before dark. There are two lighted fields for shoot-offs if necessary. After all shooters in a squad have completed shooting at a station they should examine their scores. If there is an error it must be corrected/resolved before a shot at the next station has been fired. If a shot is fired at the next station, then the results will stand — per ATA rules.

Those wishing to play the purses and options must do so at the time of entering. No additions or cancellations will be permitted after entry is made.

After the program has started and Squad 1 has shot its first field, a refund of entrance fees or purses will be made only when the program, or part of the program, is cancelled by the host club.

If you have any questions about monies ask before you enter. The cashier will gladly explain the various monies to you.

Special Categories

Lady I—may be declared if you are a female shooter who has not reached her 55th birth-day.

Lady II—may be declared if you are a female shooter who has reached her 55th birthday.

Sub-Junior—may be declared if you are a shooter who has not reached his/her 15th birth-day.

Junior—may be declared if you are a shooter who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th birthday.

Junior Gold—may be declared if you are a shooter who is 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd birthday.

Sub Veteran—may be declared if you are a shooter who is 55 but has not reached his/her 65th birthday.

Veteran—may be declared if you are a shooter who is 65 but has not reached his/her 70th birthday.

Senior Veteran—may be declared if you are a shooter who is 70 years of age or older.

Waiver and Release Agreement for the Alabama State Trapshooting Championship

The following Hold Harmless Agreement has been implemented for the Alabama State Trapshooting Championship as a requirement of our insurance carrier.

By attending the Alabama State Trapshooting Championship or paying an entry fee to participate in any of the events of the Alabama State Trapshooting Championship, held under the auspices of the Alabama State Trapshooting Association, Inc. at Dixie Trap and Gun Club, Mathews, Alabama, you agree to the terms and conditions of this waiver, to-wit:

I acknowledge and understand that trapshooting has inherent risks, hazards and dangers for anyone attending this Championship, I am voluntarily attending or participating in the Alabama State Trapshooting Championship sponsored by the Alabama State Trapshooting Association, Inc., with full knowledge of the inherent dangers involved, and I hereby assume and accept any and all risks of injury, including paralysis or death. I, for myself, my heirs, successors, beneficiaries, executors, assigns and subrogees, hereby knowingly and intentionally waive and release, indemnify and hold harmless Alabama State Trapshooting Association, Inc., Dixie Trap & Gun Club, its directors, officers, agents, employees, and volunteers, from and against any and all claims, actions, causes of action, liabilities, suits, expenses, and dangers, including personal injury and death, sustained/incurred by me, or which I cause to others, which are related to, arise out of, or are in any way connected with, my attendance or participation at this Championship.

GENERAL INFORMATION SHOOT RULES

ATA FEE- \$4.00 DAILY, STATE FEE- \$4.00 DAILY

PRACTICE TARGETS: \$7.00. This shoot and trophies open to all specified. ATA Rules will govern the shoot. The Club reserves the right to reject any entry according to ATA rules.

A contestant may win only one trophy and one added money per event, except, "Hall of Fame" in Sundays Handicap and except as provided on page 35, Section X A-E of the "Official Rule Book".

Ties for Champion Events and Handicap Trophies must be shot off the same day in 25 Target events for 16 yard and handicap, 10 pair for Doubles. Contestants not on hand for shoot offs will forfeit. The trophy goes to the winner of shoot offs for all events. High score and all ties in each class on Thursday and Friday will advance one class.

Singles—Shooters who do not have 1,000 16-yard targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous year combined shall be placed in Class B or higher at the discretion of the Classification Committee.

Handicap—Shooters who do not have 1,000 Handicap targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous year combined shall be assigned penalty yardage of 23 yards or their current handicap yardage, whichever is greater, unless they shoot TARGETS ONLY.

Doubles—Shooters who do not have 1000 Doubles targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous year combined shall be placed in Class B or higher at the discretion of the Classification Committee.

Juniors and Sub-Juniors without the minimum targets may waive the penalties and shoot category only, no options. The shoot management reserves the absolute right for classifying and assigning yardage to shooters based on the shooter's known ability in any manner that they desire for this shoot. This is in accordance with ATA rules. Any shooter abusing the pullers or scorers will be disqualified.

Food will be available on the club grounds. Popular brand shells will also be available. Supply will be limited, if any, please bring your own shells.

The shoot management reserves the right for program changes as they deem necessary for the smooth running of this shoot. However, the program will be followed unless a change is required.

GENERAL INFORMATION SHOOT RULES

All Ladies 1 & 2, Sub-Juniors, Junior Gold, Juniors, Sub-Veterans, Veterans & Sr. Veterans must declare their special category at the time of classification in any registered tournaments if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special category after firing his/her first shot. There will be no exceptions to this rule.

NOTE:

The ASTA cannot be responsible for lost checks due to an incorrect mailing address. Please verify your address at the Classification and Cashiering Desk at time of classification.

TROPHY PICK-UP

All Preliminary, Open, Non-Resident, and Resident event trophies for Championship events will be available for pick up the next day. No trophies will be mailed.

PICTURES FOR TRAP AND FIELD

The ASTA would like to request that the in State trophies winners have their picture made for possible placement in the Trap and Field Magazine at the time your trophy is picked up. Check with Shoot management about pictures.

DISQUALIFICATION NOTICE

Alcohol and /or drugs impair judgment and the ATA rules pertaining to alcohol and/or drugs will be enforced by Club Management. This rule shall be strictly complied with and shall apply to practice shooting as well as regular events. Violation of these rules will result in disqualification.

GUN SAFETY IS PROMOTED BY THE ATA. ANYONE VIOLATING GUN SAFETY RULES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM FURTHER COMPETITION.






